WHEREAS, accidents involving unintentional contact with overhead power lines occur needlessly across our state and nation each year; and

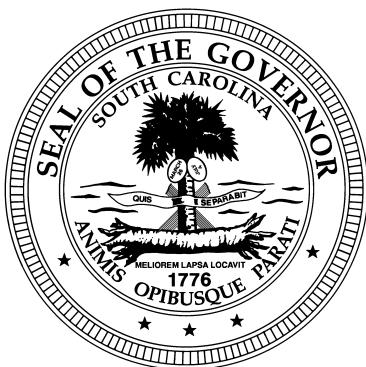
WHEREAS, between July 1999 and December 2006, there have been twenty-one serious accidents and eighteen deaths involving contact with overhead power lines in the Palmetto State; and

WHEREAS, accidents involving overhead power lines can easily be prevented by simply looking up to see if they are in the work area and taking the necessary steps to avoid contacting them.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Mark Sanford, Governor of the Great State of South Carolina, do hereby proclaim May 20 - 26, 2007, as

LOOK UP AND LIVE WEEK

throughout the state and encourage all South Carolinians to join together to help raise awareness of the need to exercise caution and remain cognizant of the danger at hand when working in areas containing overhead power lines.
